

New Astronomy Competition Course

Olympiads School will soon open a new astronomy competition course to help students prepare for the Canadian Astronomy Olympiad.

The Canadian Astronomy Olympiad is held every May for all Canadian high school students. This competition also serves to select Canadian participants in the International Olympiad of Astronomy and Astrophysics (IOAA).
