

## New COMC Classes

We are starting a new **COMC** (Canadian Open Mathematics Challenge) from **April 9**. The following is the detailed information for this class:

### 1. What is the COMC

The COMC is Canada's premier national mathematics competition. The purpose of the COMC is to encourage students to explore, discover, and learn more about mathematics and problem solving.

Approximately the top 80 students from the COMC will be invited to write the Canadian Mathematical Olympiad (CMO). Students who excel in the CMO will have the opportunity to be selected as part of Math Team Canada. The team consists of six students who will compete in the International Mathematical Olympiad (IMO).

Girls who perform well on the COMC will be eligible to write the Canadian Team Selection Test (TST). After the training and test, four students will be selected to represent Canada to participate in the European Girls' Mathematical Olympiad (EGMO).

A good COMC result will be very helpful for students when applying to STEM programs and scholarships for prestigious universities.

### 2. Olympiads School Students' COMC Results

In 2020, about 29 students from Olympiads School won national or Ontario honors for their outstanding performance in the COMC. They were also eligible to be selected for the CMO, the CMO Qualifying Repêchage Competition, and the EGMO Team Selection Test. These students were:
