Debate Training and Mock-Harvard College World Schools

To prepare students for this tournament, Meritus Academy will host debate training and mock-Harvard College World Schools on March 13 and 14 (March Break), featuring both in-person and online formats. Organizing and judging the mock-Harvard College World Schools are Meritus Academy's debate instructors, including Rudi Lof and Brent Schmidt. Below is a short introduction to each of the instructors:

Rudi Lof

Founder and President of the Toronto Debate Academy, Rudi transitioned from practicing law to coaching debate at Meritus Academy in 2011. In addition to coaching debate, Rudi also teaches law at York University.

Under Rudi's guidance, his students have won World Schools Debate Championships, Junior National Championships and several other regional championships. Since 2015, 16 of his students have qualified for Team Canada and competed in the World Schools Debating Championship (WSDC). Brent is the Debate Coach of Team Canada 2024. He has over a decade of coaching experience and has won prestigious international tournaments like HHIV, NAUDC, and WUDC. He's served on the adjudication team for Belgrade WUDC and has judged or coached at nearly every major high school and university event. With a focus on Canadian international debating, Brent has mentored students who've gone on to excel on national teams globally, nurturing some of the best high school and university debaters nationally and internationally.

There are many debate tournaments in Canada throughout the year, but very few events feature judges with capabilities and experiences like that of Rudi and Brent.

For students who will be participating at the Harvard World Schools tournament, this mock event provides invaluable preparation. For students who simply want to improve or gain more experience, this is also an excellent opportunity.

Each day will consist of 2-3 rounds of debate in World Schools format and invaluable feedback/suggestion for students' Harvard College tournament motion at the end. Students will have the exciting opportunity to be judged by Rudi, Brent, and other notable debate coaches.
