CMO Special Training Course

Meritus Academy will hold a special CMO training course from December 27, 2024 to March 2, 2025 to help students better prepare for the CMO exam.

Below is the relevant course information:

1. Course Content

The content of the course is to explain various types of problem-solving strategies and methods at the CMO level. All the questions in this class come from the Chinese Olympiad team training.

In the past 7 years, we have used these questions to train students like William Zhao, Victor Rong, Howard Halim, Thomas Guo, Michael Li, Eric Shen, David Tang, Kaixin Wang, James Yang, Emily Ma, Jerry Wang etc. and help them not only qualify for the national team, but also received gold, silver, and bronze medals at the IMO.

In addition, some students have entered the CMO top 10 through this special training, they are: Jason Yuan, Andrew Dong, Daniel Yang, Jason Zhang, Emily Ma, Bill Shen, Jerry Wang and etc.

2. Course Instructors

This course is taught by three teachers who have been teaching advanced-level mathematics competitions for a long time at Meritus Academy. They are: Dr. Tatiana Hessami Pilehrood, Dr. Emanoil Theodorescu and Dr. Allen Jiang. All the above students have received guidance and training from these three teachers.

In 2007, Dr. Allen Jiang is also the recipient of the Edyth May Sliffe Awards given by the Mathematical Association of America for outstanding teaching in mathematics. (Distinguished Mathematics Teaching in Middle School and High School was admitted as a member of the MAA)

3. Course Arrangement (The course content this year is different from last year)

- 1) Time: There are 15 classes in total. Each class is 2.5 hours. Please **click here** for the course schedule.
- 2) Tuition fee: \$25/hour, a total of 37.5 hours \times \$25 = \$937.5, please note the following situations:
 - If a student takes more than two math competition courses at Meritus Academy in fall, the course is **free**.
 - If a student takes one mathematics competition course at Meritus Academy in fall, the tuition fee is \$450. In addition, if the student also takes other courses at Meritus Academy, the tuition fee is reduced by \$30 for each additional course.
 - If a student does not take math competition classes at Meritus Academy in fall, but takes other courses, the tuition is reduced by \$40 for each course.

(P.S.: All special courses, such as repeated courses and special mock exam courses, are not eligible for discounts.)
