

## New AMC 8 Workshop

Meritus Academy will open a special Math Competition course from August 1 to 15 - AMC 8 workshop. This workshop is suitable for students who are in Grades 7-8 and below. The purpose is to help students familiar with the difficulty level of the AMC 8 problems and demonstrate different problem-solving strategies.

This workshop will be taught by Andy Song, an outstanding student who was accepted by Princeton University this year. In Grade 5, Andy enrolled in the Grade 8 math competition course at Meritus Academy, and has shown a solid mathematical background and learning ability.

He has excelled in several math competitions over the past few years, especially in the AMC 10 and AMC 12 series, and has qualified for the AIME (American Invitational Mathematics Contest) several times.

Andy will not only explain the competition questions, but also share his learning experience and discuss mathematical thinking with the children to foster their interest and potential in math. Everyone is welcome to attend.
